EDITORIAL COMMENTS



We recognize the importance of sharing vital information with the electorate as the Thomas led administration continues to decline with its warring and renegade coalition partners.

Since our last newsletter, the National Democratic Congress (NDC) has grown into further decay and denial. The sudden unexplained departure of the NDC Chairperson from Grenada to a North America Country shows the NDC disrespect to Grenadians; Thomas's recent poor performance at a Toronto press conference organized by the local consular mission prior to addressing. NNP'S RESCUE PLAN ALSO CALLS FOR MINISTERIAL DISCIPLINE AND RESPECT:

NNP'S Grenada rescue plan will also ensure that discipline and good ministerial conduct are demanded and practiced as the process of governing takes place.

The NNP is appalled at the ongoing disrespect shown by several Ministers and their advisers. A glaring case is the behaviour of Minister Burke and his rebranding of the Economic Citizenship Program, the Grenada Individual Investment Program which he attempted to pilot through even if it was not discussed in the Cabinet nor given the necessary approval. Mr. Burke's Private Sector point man in the Ministry of finance Mr. Chris De Riggs also has compromised the principles of the Cabinet as Mr. Gilbert was accused. It is alleged that he has given written commitments on Citizenship acquisition to potential foreign investors. Unlike Mr. Joseph Gilbert who was sacked as a minister by Prime Minister Tillman Thomas, Mr. Burke and Mr. De Riggs are the exception to the rule of Hon. Thomas. These double standards once again demonstrate Prime Minister Thomas's weak and indifferent leadership.

PM THOMAS DISMISSES ALBA AND URGES HIS CARIBBEAN COUNTERPARTS TO FOCUS ON CARICOM:



PM Thomas tells Caribbean News Now Rebecca Theodore what he thinks about ALBA and his Caribbean Colleagues

Prime Minister Thomas has urged Caribbean leaders to place more emphasis on the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) instead of the Bolivarian Alliance for the Peoples of Our Americas (ALBA), Thomas made these bold faced comments during a media brief in Toronto on February 17,2012 at the Consulate of Grenada. PM Thomas emphasised strongly that he believes a nation with strong values is more important than money. Is Prime Minister Tillman Thomas saying that St. Vincent, Antiqua and Barbuda and Dominica who are members of ALBA do not have strong values?

ALBA is made up of Venezuela, Cuba, Bolivia, Nicaragua, Dominica, Antigua and Barbuda, Ecuador and St Vincent and the Grenadines and was in the news in a Caribbean context recently when leaders of all eight countries reportedly agreed to block any ships flying the Falkland Islands flag from docking in their ports. The three Commonwealth Caribbean members of ALBA later backtracked on the reported agreement.

WILL NDC CHAIRMAN KENRICK FULLERTON RETURN TO BATTLE NNP'S ROLAND BHOLA IN NORTH EAST ST. ANDREWS?

The above question is constantly been asked all around the North East St. Andrew Constituency which Roland Bhola ably represents. Why is this question being asked? A few months ago the NDC loudly cheered when Chairperson Kenrick Fullerton and long-time Peter David loyalist was selected to represent the NDC against Bhola. Current information indicates that Fullerton has left the Nation for an unknown destination in North America. After his re-election success in 2003, Elections, Bhola was appointed as Minister of Sports, Community Development and Co-Operatives. Roland ably represents the people of his constituency of St Andrew's North East. He also ascribes to the fact that he represents all of St Andrew's, St Patrick and St David's, since none of these areas have representation on the opposition side in Parliament at this time. He has the capacity to succeed in solving difficult problems. He is patriotic, loves his people, his nation and best of all he loves himself.

NAZIM: IS A NEW ECONOMIC CITIZENSHIPPROGRAM IN THE MAKING? BE TRANSPARENT TO THE VOTERS:

The New National Party (NNP) which governed Grenada up to 2008 was always conscious about the need for innovative and diverse economic development activities and programs. It was within this context that the then administration established the Grenada Economic Citizenship Program which brought many economic benefits to Grenadians but was persistently hammered by Burke and his deceptive National Development Congress (NDC).

Now that the horse is out of the stable, Finance Minister Burke and his private sector point man at his Ministry have found themselves at odd on the above policy thus demonstrating more deception and tomfoolery to the Grenadian electorate who continue to grow weary about NDC trickery and lies.

Given the confusion that currently exists about the Grenada Individual Investor Program (GIIP) which is a de facto economic citizenship program, it is extremely difficult to separate the behavior of the Minister and Director of Private Sector Development. Since being appointed to the well remunerated position, most observers agree that De Riggs have not delivered much and it is yet another embarrassment for Nazim and Prime Minister Tillman Thomas.

While Nazim continue to emphasize to the local media that GIIP has not been approved by Cabinet, the minister's comment contradicts promises in a letter written last year by Christopher De Riggs to the head of a Chinese financial company.

The letter written by De Riggs and copied to Burke,— it is alleged assured the Chairman of the Board of Touchstone Capital Partners Enterprise of China that the "the government of Grenada accepted the Touchstone proposal" for resident status for potential investors, provided that "the applicants shall pay all applicable fees associated with their application."

The issue at the centre of the exchange between De Riggs and Touchstone, which was promising to invest up to US\$50 million in Grenada, parallels the GIIP talk shows that currently consume Burke's time.
